



Car Boot Sale Terms and Conditions

1. Doors are open to sellers from 7am to 7.55am. If you fail to arrive before 7.55am you will not be allocated your space or receive a refund.
2. All sellers must be set up prior to 8am.
3. Receipts for purchased tables must be collected from reception before 4 pm on the Saturday prior to the event.
4. Receipts must be taken to the event as these are your proof of purchase.
5. Wrist bands will be issued to sellers upon entry. These bands must be worn as they identify you as a seller who is permitted to access the hall from 7am.
6. From 7.55am the fire exit doors will be closed and you will not be able to gain entry. If you wish to access the hall after 7.55 am this will be through the main entrance doors.
7. Buyers are not permitted to enter the hall until 8am.
8. Car boot sale runs until 1pm, de-rig for sellers is from 1pm to 1.30pm.
9. Tickets are non-transferable. You are not permitted to resell purchased tables.
10. Cars must be moved from the main car park to the overflow car park before 8am.
11. The following products and items are prohibited from being sold at the event: alcohol, tobacco products, drug paraphernalia, weapons and pirate copy films and cd's. Inverness Leisure reserves the right to remove any item that may be deemed inappropriate.
12. Sellers must not exceed their allocated table space and must keep walkways clear for patrons.
13. Clothes rails are permitted but these must not protrude onto walkways and cause any obstructions.
14. If you wish you can leave any unwanted items in the hall that you did not sell and we will donate these to charity. Please note that we will not be able to accept electrical items.
15. Sellers are reminded that home baking is not permitted to be sold in the premises unless the seller has the appropriate food hygiene certificates and licences. These must be available for inspection upon request during the event. Inverness Leisure will not allow any persons to sell any items without the correct documentation.
16. Inverness Leisure would like to make sellers aware that should any CD's be left after the conclusion of the car boot sale then IL reserves the right to collect these for use within the facilities PA system in accordance with our Corporate Social Responsibility in relation to recycling.
